

# Cranberry Patch

Thank you for your interest in the book, "The How to Book of Hemstitching and Edging". Here is a pattern for the couch throw pictured on the front cover of the book.

To make the "Cranberry Patch" couch throw, purchase 2 1/2 yards of monk's cloth. Stay stitch edges. Wash and dry in the dryer to pre-shrink. Fold the fabric in quarters and mark the center float. The center float is the star on the pattern. Red Heart's sage, dark sage and burgundy worsted weight yarns were used to stitch this project on natural monk's cloth.

Yarn Lengths:

Rows 27, 30:	1 1/4 times the length plus 8 inches	Row 3:	2 times the length plus 8 inches
Rows 1, 26, 29:	1 1/2 times the length plus 8 inches	Row 4:	2 1/4 times the length plus 8 inches
Rows 2, 6 - 25, 28, 31:	1 3/4 times the length plus 8 inches	Row 5:	2 1/2 times the length plus 8 inches
